Dear *Sgt. Pavin*,

Your son/daughter *Rayton*..... will be leaving Prince Rupert School on Monday, 27th July - the military authorities have arranged for the school party to leave a day earlier than we expected.

The military boat on which the party will travel is timed to arrive at Harwich at 06.30 hrs. on Tuesday, 28th July. There are two trains to London, one arriving at Liverpool Street Station at 10.21 hrs. and the other at 11.14 hrs. It is impossible to say which train will carry our party, so will you please meet the earlier one.

My request that two teachers be allowed to accompany the party has been refused but some of the oldest and most responsible children in the school including three monitors and a prefect will be travelling and I do not anticipate that there will be any difficulties.
