

NOTES

It is the responsibility of Units to ensure that :-

1. The customer's rank, name and unit are recorded on the front page of this Card at time of issue. In the case of wives' and children's Cards, the husband's rank and unit must be shown.
 2. When Cards are issued to entitled customers, both permanent and temporary visitors, a memo, giving the number of the Card and particulars of the customer, as described in para. 1 above, must be submitted to the Families Shop at which the holder will deal.
 3. Where it is necessary for Cards to be issued to families after the commencement of an allocation period, care must be taken by the issuing Unit to ensure that sections on the Card applicable to the period prior to the customer's arrival in BAOR are cancelled before the Card is issued. Cancellation is to be effected by punching holes in the appropriate spaces.
 4. When a customer is posted from BAOR the Trading Card must be withdrawn by the Unit concerned, and destroyed. At the same time the Manager of the Families Shop concerned must be notified, in order that the customer's name is deleted from the shop register.
 5. Specially stamped NAAFI Trading Cards are available for issue to relatives on short visits to BAOR, which must be returned to Units for cancellation, as and when the holder returns to the UK.
 6. Customers are permitted to purchase non-rationed goods and commodities, not on allocation, from any NAAFI Shop in BAOR.
 7. Date of Birth must be shown on all Children's Trading Cards.
- Expectant mothers and invalids will be entitled to purchase Special Welfare Foods only if the applicable certificate has been completed by the M.O.
